Empower Kids A Joint Project by Arts-Kids & Swaner Nature Preserve

"11 years after my breast cancer ordeal, my 21-year old daughter recently shared with me how scared she was," says a Park City mother. Most children's fears and anxieties are not adequately addressed during and after a parent's cancer treatment. On October 8th and 14th, Arts-Kids and Swaner Nature Preserve offered EMPOW-ER KIDS, two half-day workshops featuring community promoting activities and healing expressive arts. After a guided nature walk on the preserve, Arts-Kids resident artist, Jennifer Prochazka lead the participants through a guided imagination process, followed by the creation of

a collage and a mask. "Children 'mask' their fear," says Prochazka, "so this activity allowed them to express their true feelings." During community circle activities and art creation, participants reflected on their experiences. Lunch was donated by Whole Foods Market to promote healthy eating habits, an integral part of cancer prevention and recovery. While support for adult cancer survivors is available, there are few services for children. Arts-Kids and Swaner Nature Preserve hope to continue to fill this much needed void.
